



**COVID-19 UPDATE: IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT – RESTRICTED
MOVEMENT ORDER STARTING FROM WEDNESDAY, 18TH MARCH
2020 TO TUESDAY, 31ST MARCH 2020**
17th March 2020

Dear Students,

The Malaysian Government has just declared that **the entire Malaysia will be on restricted movement order starting from Wednesday, 18th March to Tuesday, 31st March 2020 to deal with the COVID-19 situation.** This includes prohibition of entry of foreign visitors.

In compliance with this directive, APU & APIIT will be closed from Wednesday, 18th March to Tuesday, 31st March 2020.

However, to facilitate the return of our international students after the 31st of March, normal operations will only commence on 6th of April at the earliest. Should the COVID-19 situation not normalise by then, this date may be further revised.

All Examinations from Wednesday, 18th March to Sunday, 5th April 2020 will be rescheduled to a later date, which will be announced later.

For students who are living in KL, please note that the supermarkets, grocery stores and stores selling basic necessities will be operational during this time. This is not a lock down, but restricted movement order.

Students who wish to go back to their home town or country, can travel during this time. We will continue to update you.

APU's services including all administrative functions will function as normal on Tuesday, 17th March 2020.

For students who will continue to live in KL, we would like to assure all students and parents that APU will remain in touch with our students during these 2 weeks plus and provide any assistance that may be required.
