



EXTENSION OF CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (CMCO)

Monday, 7th December 2020

Following the recent announcement by the Senior Minister for Security, the **Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) in Kuala Lumpur & Selangor (except Hulu Selangor, Sabak Bernam and Kuala Selangor)** has been extended to **Sunday, 20th December 2020**.

All university campuses will continue to be closed for physical teaching & learning activities, and a majority of our staff members & lecturers will continue to perform their lectures & duties from home as per the CMCO SOPs. Essential services such as visa services, administrative services, accommodation services and bursary services will continue to operate. However, **entry to the campus will continue to be restricted and students are required to make an appointment here 24 hours prior to their visit:** <http://www.apu.edu.my/explore-apu/contact-us>.
